

WSCF - What is Ecumenical Mission on Campus?

What does mission mean on a University Campus?

How do we reach students?

What happens when you bring an ecumenical group of students together?

Using an interactive game we can learn how WSCF works as an ecumenical student movement. The goal will be to help students and chaplains to engage in ecumenism on their own campus. Following the work shop you can have a provocative discussion about mission in an ecumenical setting will be facilitated. Through the discussion you can come up with concrete tools and resources on how to best reach students.

Directions:

Cut out the cards below and distribute them among the participants. Each participant has a role that they will then act out for the next 30 minutes. Some roles are more concrete than others with specific tasks. Debrief after the activity and have each person explain how easy or difficult it was to complete their role.

Start a social justice revolution – convince everyone of your cause! Do you want to feed the hungry or save the forests? You only have 30 minutes to get everyone on board!
Be as creative as you can.



Get political!
Your faith means action in the world. Convince everyone to be vocal activists on student rights.



Find a place in the room and meditate.



Make everyone more comfortable. Make tea, get water, meet the needs of the people here



You are too shy to disagree with anyone.

Perhaps you are a new student or just not that outgoing.



Follow the group!



Meet every single person in the room and get to know them personally.



Follow the actions of the first person you meet. Let them guide you through the group



You are a very liberal Christian.
You don't believe in Hell, or the devil.

You are extremely uneasy of what others are planning to do.



Organise a 5 minute ecumenical prayer to begin twenty minutes into this activity.

Find Participants!



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Try to find all the Catholic students to attend mass...

A pretend mass to be held outside the room at sometime during the role-play



Organise a group of students to go out for a beer discussion night tonight.
The theme: “God on Tap – discussions of faith”



Find those who are left out and make sure they feel welcome



Sit in a corner and only give one word answers if asked questions.



Ask everyone as many questions as you can about what they are doing.
You are curious about spiritual life and want advice!



Follow the group.



You are too shy to disagree with anyone.

Campus is no place for the Church. You believe in a separation between Church and State as well as Faith and Education.
